(This show was intended to be the Ziegfeld Follies of 1926; however, due to litigation Ziegfeld could not use the word Follies. So he opened the show in Florida under the name Ziegfeld's Palm Beach Nights. After the Palm Beach Season, Ziegfeld moved the show to New York under the name of Ziegfeld's Palm Beach Girl for rehearsals. Due to the success of the song No Foolin' he opened the show under that name (see #1651) at the Globe Theatre on June 24, 1926. It was retitled Ziegfeld's American Revue of 1926 (sometimes just Ziegfeld's Revue of 1926) shortly after opening, and closed September 25, 1926, after 108 performances. When Ziegfeld won his legal battle and regained his rights, then he finally could use the name Ziegfeld Follies of 1926 for the subsequent national tour)
