

2558 ZIEGFELD'S AMERICAN REVUE OF 1926

Musical Revue, 1926

(This show was intended to be the *Ziegfeld Follies of 1926*; however, due to litigation Ziegfeld could not use the word *Follies*. So he opened the show in Florida under the name *Ziegfeld's Palm Beach Nights*. After the Palm Beach Season, Ziegfeld moved the show to New York under the name of *Ziegfeld's Palm Beach Girl* for rehearsals. Due to the success of the song *No Foolin'* he opened the show under that name (see #1651) at the Globe Theatre on June 24, 1926.

It was retitled *Ziegfeld's American Revue of 1926* (sometimes just *Ziegfeld's Revue of 1926*) shortly after opening, and closed September 25, 1926, after 108 performances. When Ziegfeld won his legal battle and regained his rights, then he finally could use the name *Ziegfeld Follies of 1926* for the subsequent national tour)

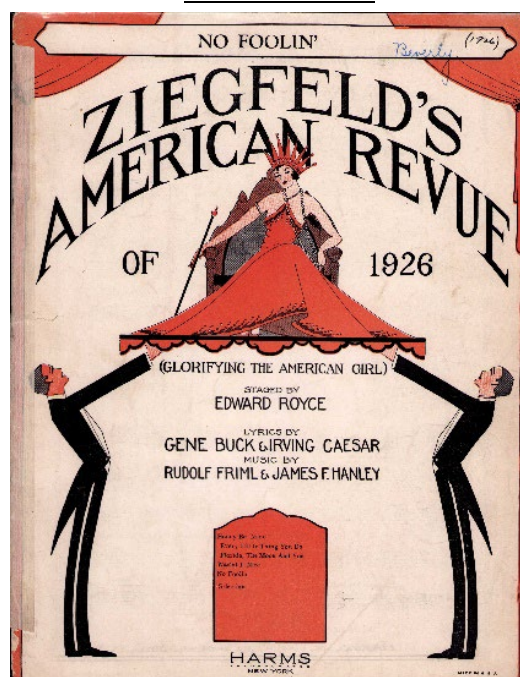

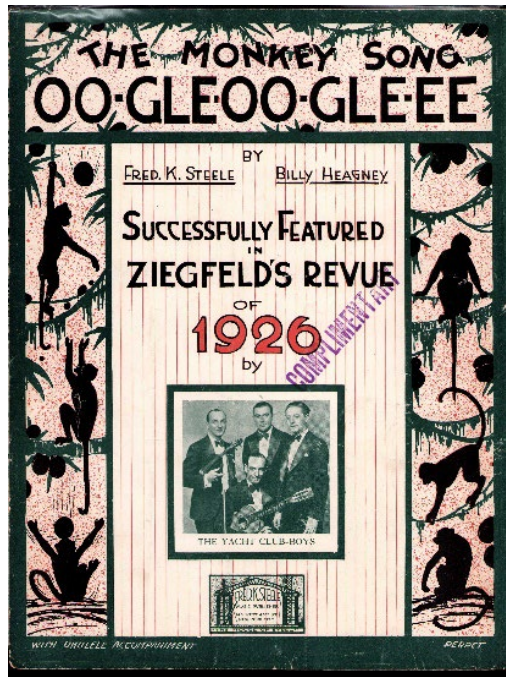

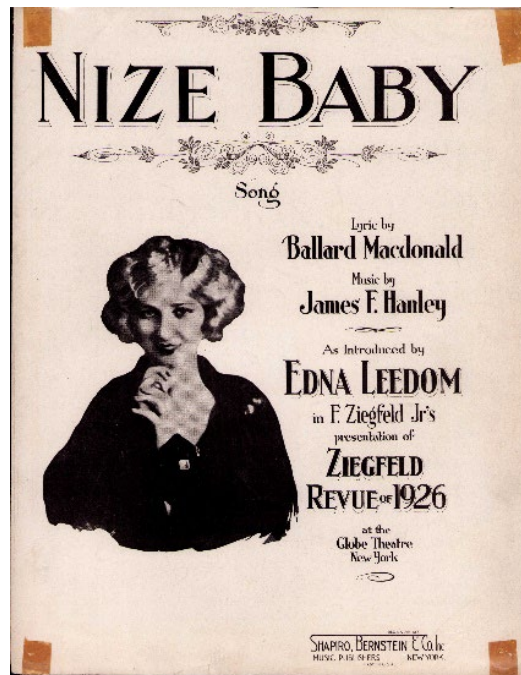
