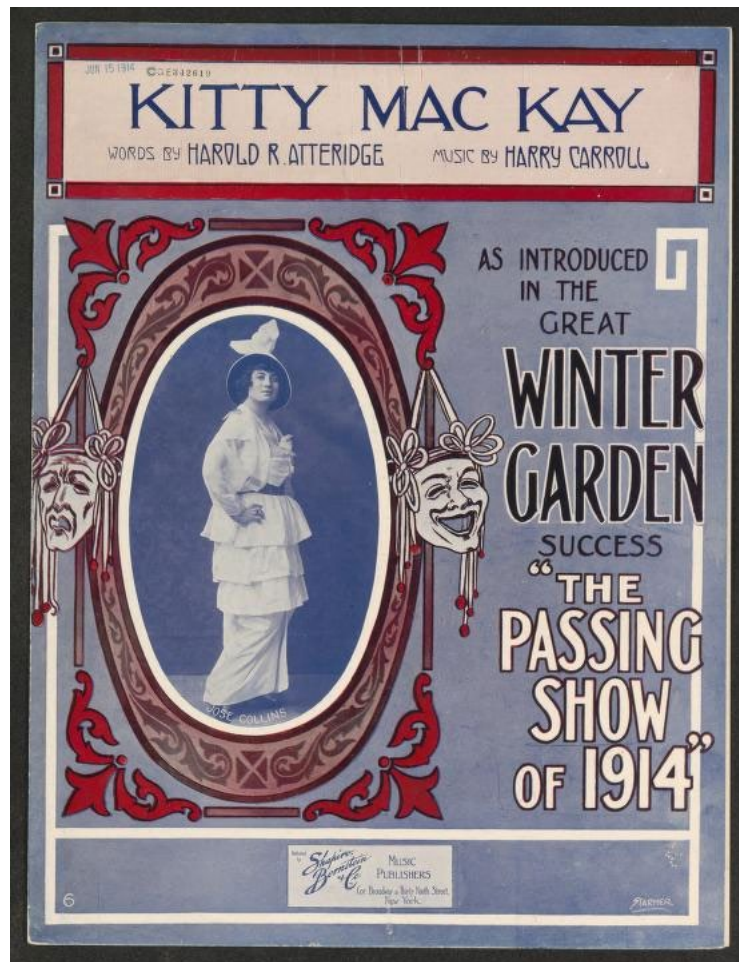
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Harry Carroll, the secondary composer for *The Passing Show of 1914*, provided the character [Kitty MacKay] with an opening song complete with chorus that sings and dances a Scottish can-can in the tune, “Kitty MacKay.” The music, however, was entirely new . . . and provided [José] Collins a feature role amidst a bevy of beautiful chorus girls.
